PITCHES FROM £10*

All pitch and electricity costs are listed on the booking form.

If you can bring your own table, let us know, however, we have a number of 1.8m x 1.2m tables we can be provided for inside pitches.

Outside pitches are 3x3m. We recommend that you bring your own table/s and gazebo as we have limited numbers. These are booked on a first-come, first-serve basis. It is worth noting that if you need to borrow a gazebo your pitch size will vary depending on which size gazebos are available.

PITCH LOCATIONS

Pitches are located in Market Hall, Market Strand, Fore Street and Green Lane. See map for general locations.

Pitch locations are determined by the Engagement Team at Redruth Town Council but you may request a particular spot, we will accommodate you where possible on a first come first serve basis.

Please note that pitch locations cannot be changed once the street plan has been sent out to traders so make any location requests on our booking form.

SET UP TIME

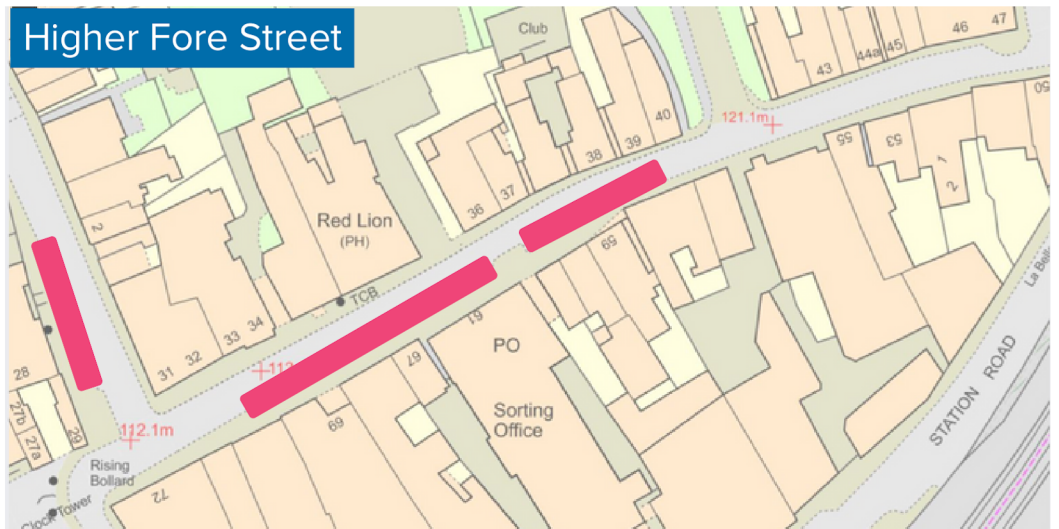
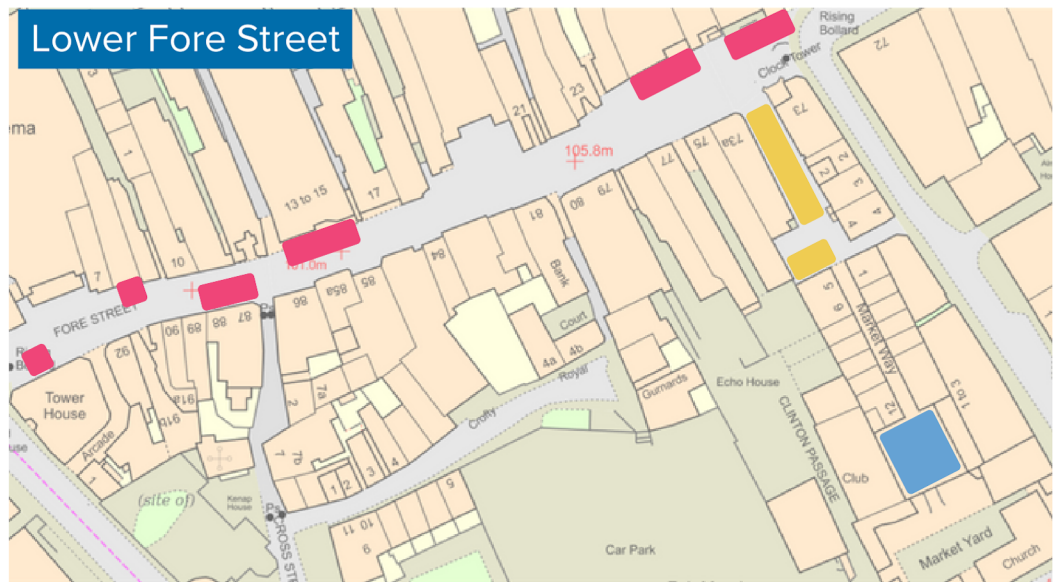
You can start setting up 1.5 hours before the festival starts but no later than 30 mins. If you are borrowing equipment from us, please note it is unlikely all of the gazebos will be up and ready 1.5 hours before the festival starts – please bear with us and we will work as quickly as we can.

CLOSEST CAR PARKS

Fairmeadow car park, TR15 2PP - closest to Market Hall and Market Strand stalls

New Cut Extension, Redruth, TR15 1AF - closest to Lower Fore Street and Green stalls. Do make sure you park in the long stay part of the carpark and not the larger short stay section.

Flowerpot Chapel, Redruth, TR15 2AE - closest to Higher Fore Street stalls. If this is closed on a festival day use the New Cut Extension car park.



UNLOADING

Fore Street, Green Lane, and Alma Place will all be closed however you can drive through the closure to unload your stall and then go off to park. Arrival for setting up on time is important as all vehicles must be cleared from inside the road closures 30 minutes before each event.

To reduce congestion during set up and pack down time please follow this guide:

- For Traders located at: Market Strand, Green Lane and Higher Fore Street please come in via Alma Place
- Traders in Market Hall: The walk way through the Buttermarket renovations will be open so you can park in Fairmeadow and carry your stock through this entrance.
- Lower Fore Street: Please drive up from the bottom of Fore Street to your pitch to unload or park in the car parks and carry your kit if you can.
