Please inform your coach of any pre-existing medical conditions that you (or that whom you are responsible for) have that we may need to know about in the event of an emergency:

Helmet protection is compulsory for all riders. If you choose to skate without a helmet you do so at your own risk. We highly recommend that knee and elbow pads are also worn to reduce risk of injury. Coach Frank Skateschool can provide safety equipment on request.

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- Coach Frank Coaches reserve the right to ask any skateboarder to leave a lesson at any point. This will be on the grounds of disruption, bullying or dangerous behaviour, to protect the safety and wellbeing of the other skaters.
 - Coach Frank Skateschool will not be held responsible for the loss, damage or theft of any items during a session.
 - When booking a lesson you will receive confirmation. Without confirmation we cannot guarantee your lesson will go ahead, nor can we guarantee you a space in one of our lessons.
 - In the event of wet weather conditions, outdoor lessons must be cancelled for health and safety reasons. Any payments made will be refunded within a reasonable time.
 - If an injury is sustained within the first 15 minutes of the lesson, preventing further skating, a refund will be issued upon request within a reasonable time.
 - We do not allow longboards, penny boards or other cruiser skateboards. If you do not own a suitable skateboard, we offer them to hire, free of charge.
